#### NOTE:

1.4 Personal Protective Equipment

Anti-slip shoes are required to protect against slipping on slippery surfaces.

#### 1.5 Power Supply 🗥 The device must only be operated with the provided power supply unit.

To reduce the risk of electric shock: Do not touch the device if it falls into water. Immediately unplug it from the socket. Do not use while bathing or showering. Do not place or store the appliance where it may fall or be pulled into a tub or sink. Do not place it in or drop it into water or other liquids. Always unplug the appliance from the electrical outlet immediately after use, except when charging. Unplug the appliance before cleaning.

To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons: Never leave the appliance unattended when it is plugged in. Do not use attachments not specified by the manufacturer. The clipper's battery pack may vent or rupture if crushed, heated, incinerated, short-circuited, or immersed in any liquid. Do not insert metallic objects into the battery cavities of the charging station.

To clean external parts of the charging station, use a soft brush or damp cloth. Do not use harsh abrasives, detergents, or solvents. Do not use this lithium-ion battery to power any product other than the Joyzze Raptor clipper.

The battery contains an overload protection feature. In extreme cases, overload protection may cause the battery to become inoperable. For maximum battery life, do not store clipper, charging station or battery pack under 50°F or over 104°F.

Do not expose the clipper, charging station or battery pack to excessively damp conditions.

Take care not to drop the clipper, charging station or battery pack. Do not attempt to use a damaged charging station or battery pack.

## 1.7 Animals 🖄

The appliance is intended for trimming purposes only. The noise of the clipper can disturb animals. The animal should be fixed and calmed sufficiently before clipping. Do not charge, install or leave the device in places where it may be exposed to damage from an animal.

## 1.8 Clipping Blades 🛆

Moving blades and sharp edges of the blades can cause injuries to the skin. Work carefully. Avoid any contact with the moving blades.

#### FAILURE TO CHARGE

Make sure the outlet is working and plugs are well seated in the clipper and outlet. If clipper still fails to charge return for maintenance (see Manufacturer's 12 Month Limited Warranty).

### LITHIUM-ION BATTERY USE, STORAGE, AND DISPOSAL

- 1. The Joyzze Raptor Cordless Clipper comes with a rechargeable lithium-ion battery pack. The battery does not develop a "memory effect". You can return the battery pack to the charger at any time for a full charge, or even use the battery before a charge cycle is complete. Like most rechargeable batteries, lithium-ion batteries perform best when used frequently.
- 2. For maximum battery life, if the battery pack will be in storage from several months or longer, store with a partial battery charge of about 40%.
- 3. Store battery pack in temperatures between 50°F/10°C and 104°F/40°C. Do not store in damp conditions.
- 4. Do not place the clipper and the battery pack near heat vents, radiators, or in direct sunlight. Optimal charging requires stable temperature conditions while sudden increases in temperature will reduce battery charge capacity.
- 5. Initially, new lithium-ion batteries, unused for a period of time, may not accept a full charge. This is normal and does not indicate a problem with the battery or charger. The battery will accept a full charge after several cycles of clipper use and recharging.
- 6. When not in use for extended periods, disconnect the adapter cord from the AC outlet.
- 7. Many factors influence lithium-ion battery life. A battery that has received heavy use or is more than a year old may not give the same run-time performance as a new battery pack.
- 8. Check with your municipal solid waste organizations for details on lawful disposal and recycling options.

## RAPTOR CORDED

(1) Slide the Direct Operation Adaptor into the Clipper Body. ② Insert the power adapter output plug to the Direct Operation Adaptor. ③ Connect the power adapter to the wall outlet. ④ Press and hold the Multi-function button for 0.6sec to switch the clipper ON.

## RAPTOR CORDLESS

Slide the charged battery pack into the clipper body. Press and hold the Multi-function button for 0.6sec to switch the clipper ON.

\* The battery pack and the direct operation adaptor are removable from the clipper. press the release button and push them slide out.







#### Multi-function Button

① Press and hold the button for 0.6 sec to switch the clipper ON/OFF. After the clipper is powered on, the default speed is 3100 SPM.

(2) Short press to switching the speed: 3100 - 3800 - 2500, which can be cyclic switching.

## CHARGING OPERATION

The clipper, which already has an installed battery pack, can be directly put in the primary cavity for charging. Or only put a battery pack in the primary cavity for charging.



#### BATTERY POWER INDICATE

On the bottom of the power adaptor, hold down the button to view the battery charge level.

No LED light up: Exhausted or faulty battery - Try recharge. Blinking one LED: Battery level ca. 0-10% – Recharge immediately. One LED lights up: Battery level ca. 11-35% Two LEDs light up: Battery level ca. 36-66% Three LEDs light up: Battery level ca. > 66% \* LEDs will be off automatically after 5 seconds after release the button.



#### BATTERY CHARGING INDICATOR

The red light is always on when the battery is charging, and the green light is always on after the battery is fully charged.

#### CHARGING OPERATION

There are two cavities in the charging station, which can intelligently charge the two battery packs.\*

① When the two battery packs are placed in the two cavities at a same time, the battery pack in the primary cavity will be charged first.

② When the battery pack in the primary cavity is fully charged, or removed from of the primary cavity, it will continue to charge the spare battery pack in the secondary cavity.

\*Batteries will not simultaneously charge



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\* Store charging station in a clean location. If the battery cavities becomes clogged with dust or hair, unplug the adaptor and gently remove hair or other debris with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner.

#### BLADE INSTALLATION

Insert the blade slot into the blade latch, and fold it on to the switched-on clipper by light pressure, press the blade down and hear a "click".



#### BLADE REMOVAL

Push the release button to the end, at the same time, fold the blade backward, pull the blade out of the latch with another hand to take off the blade.



## CAUTION: Turn OFF the clipper and disconnect from outlet before performing maintenance.

## ♦ BLADE REMOVAL ⚠

If the blade latch is accidentally closed, please use a flat screwdriver, insert into the latch gap and pry it up as figure suggests.

CAUTION is advised to not damage any components while conducting the suggested method above.

#### ♦ BLADE MAINTENANCE

1. Blade cleaning: Move the shear blade within a short range and use the brush to remove hair that is stuck between the shear blade and the comb blade.





2. Blade oiling: The blades must be oiled before, during and after every use. When the blades of the clipper are leaving stripes, this is a signal that oil is required.

Place 1-2 drops of lubricating oil ahead and laterally on the blade shown below. Wipe off the excessive oil with a smooth, dry cloth.



In order to achieve optimal clipping performance and enhance the longevity of both the clipper and the blade, it is important to apply a thin coat of oil between the top and bottom blades.

If the blade is not adequately lubricated, it can cause heating and decrease the durability of the clipper, blades and may reduce the battery runtime

Lubricate the blades sufficiently during the clipping (at least every 15 minutes) or battery drainage can occur. \*Only use Joyzze special lubricant oil. See Joyzze.com for details.

#### UNIVERSAL POWER ADAPTER

 The universal power adaptor is equipped with interchangeable wall plugs that support universal AC voltage, making it suitable for use in most countries worldwide.

Installation:

To attach the desired plug to the power adapter, align the slots on the plug to the ribs on the power adapter. Turn clockwise into place. The plug will "click" into place when properly attached.

Removing:

Simultaneously push the button on the power adaptor and turn the plug counterclockwise to remove it.



Note:

That it is normal for the battery pack and power adapter to feel warm to the touch when charging or running. This is especially true if the battery has been deeply discharged and/or while the clipper is running.
